Teaching Australia has released a draft version of the **National Professional Standards for Advanced Primary Teaching**. ALEA is hosting a series of consultation sessions throughout multiple states and territories to seek feedback from primary teachers, principals and other interested stakeholders. You, or your colleagues, are cordially invited to register your attendance at the **ALEA Queensland event**, to be held on **Thursday 11 June, 2009** at Golden Buddha, 3 The Corso, Seven Hills (Norman Park) from 5pm-7pm. *You do not need to be an ALEA member to register.*

This is your opportunity to have **substantial input** into the next steps in the development of this document whilst also exercising **your professionalism** in helping to shape the ways forward, and providing advice and feedback to Teaching Australia. These standards will have significant impact on how teachers are assessed, criteria for employment and registration and possibly remuneration.
